**Full Time Registered Nurse Position**

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**Position:** This is a Bargaining Unit Contract Position (80 hours in a two-week period) position.

**Purpose of the Position:**

Reporting to the Program Manager, the Registered Nurse participates as a member of a multidisciplinary team, to provide treatment, rehabilitation, support and crisis intervention services for individuals with serious and persistent mental illness in the clients' environment of choice.

- Current Registration in good standing with the Ontario College of Nurses
- Bachelor's Degree or Diploma in Nursing
- Additional training or qualifications in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing
- Knowledge of the Assertive Community Treatment Team Model (ACTT) □ A minimum of 3-5 years experience with individuals with mental illness □ Demonstrated knowledge, skill and experience in:
  - Psychosocial rehabilitation
    - Conducting mental status examinations;
    - Assessing, managing and evaluating crisis situations;
    - Conducting physical assessments
    - Developing treatment plans for clients living in the community
- Knowledge of current psychotropic medications, including side effects and therapeutic effects.
- Demonstrated ability to develop and maintain effective professional and therapeutic relationships
- Knowledge of Mental Health Reform, the Mental Health Act, and other appropriate legislation
- Knowledge of housing, social, financial and vocational and other community resources
- Demonstrated commitment to professional development
- Demonstrated capacity to work effectively in a team

- Demonstrated ability to be flexible in work assignments and work effectively under pressure
